### **Position(s): Dragon Boat Coordinator and Coaches**

The Dragon Boat Coordinator will lead the planning and delivery of safe, engaging, and developmentally appropriate programming for CPCC's Dragon Boat participants. Dragon Boat Coaches will support program delivery by leading teams through training sessions and ensuring high-quality programming aligned with the seasonal plan developed by the coordinator. The coordinator is also responsible for program development, festival entries, and festival management for all CPCC Dragon Boat teams.

### **Responsibilities**

- Lead the planning and implementation of all CPCC Dragon Boat programs
- Collaborate with the Head Coach and management team to develop and implement creative, innovative, and effective seasonal and weekly program plans
- Communicate professionally with participants and the CPCC management team (welcome emails, regular updates, responding to inquiries, phone communications, etc.)
- Work with management and the CPCC coaching team to ensure program equipment and facilities are clean, safe, and in good working condition
- Attend all Dragon Boat training sessions and competitions, and regularly assess both participant development and overall program quality
- Attend all club-hosted events, including Dragon Boat festivals and club social events
- Coordinate with the Head Coach and coaching team to complete all Dragon Boat program-related festival entries
- Ensure member compliance with club safety standards and the CPCC Code of Conduct
- Participate in weekly staff meetings as required
- Complete a season-end program review
