



### **Carleton Place Canoe Club Boat Storage Policy**

The Carleton Place Canoe Club offers space for members who own personal boats to store them in our facility. Assignment of the space, or place of storage is up to management and the Head Coach & Technical Director.

**To be eligible** for boat storage inside the Carleton Place Canoe Club boat bays, you must meet **all** of the following conditions:

- Must be registered in a CPCC program during the season of storage and be in good standing with the CPCC and our affiliates
- Must be registered for boat storage through our website and must have paid the storage fee of either:
  - **Annual Storage:** \$100 per boat, per year.
  - **Seasonal Storage:** \$60 per boat, per term.

#### **BOAT STORAGE TERMS:**

- **Annual boat storage** fees are to be paid once per year. The storage term is set as May 1st – April 30th. This means that the **term/year resets on May 1st of every year.**
- **Seasonal boat storage** fees are to be paid prior to the start of the storage term. The storage **term is set as May 1st – August 31st.** Seasonal storage registrants must remove their boats from the CPCC boat bays by September 1st.

#### **ADDITIONAL BOAT STORAGE CONDITIONS:**

- Members in programs that require more frequent use of equipment will be given priority storage spaces
  - Head Coach & Management reserve the right to reassign boat locations at any time
- Members who move boats or do not respect others equipment run the risk of losing their boat storage privileges at the CPCC
- Unpaid boat storage fees, by the deadlines outlined above, will result in forfeiture of the assigned space

Boat storage fees are applied per boat. Therefore, you are required to pay for each boat being stored in the boat bays.

**BOAT STORAGE FOR STAFF:** Staff members are able to store their boats with the CPCC for free if equipment is being used for coaching purposes only. Staff members registered in a program with the CPCC will be required to pay the boat storage fee at a discounted rate of \$60 per year.
